Manalapan-Englishtown Community Alliance Hosts Free Narcan Training

The Manalapan-Englishtown Community Alliance to Prevent Alcoholism and Drug Abuse is pleased to announce the holding of a free Narcan training at Manalapan Town Hall on Monday, February 27, 2017 starting at 7:00 pm. The training is a joint project of the Jersey Shore Addiction Services (JSAS) Health Care organization and the Barnabas Health Institute for Prevention with funding from the Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services of the New Jersey Department of Human Services.

The training is open to anyone who is at risk of an opioid overdose or their family and friends. All eligible participants will receive a free Narcan (naloxone) kit and a treatment voucher for 30 days of free substance abuse treatment to use or distribute to any person that needs medication-assisted treatment. In addition, education will be provided on how to administer Narcan to reverse a heroin/opioid overdose.

The training is limited to a maximum of 25 persons. Admittance will be on a first come – “first served” basis. The training will be held in Manalapan Town Hall.
