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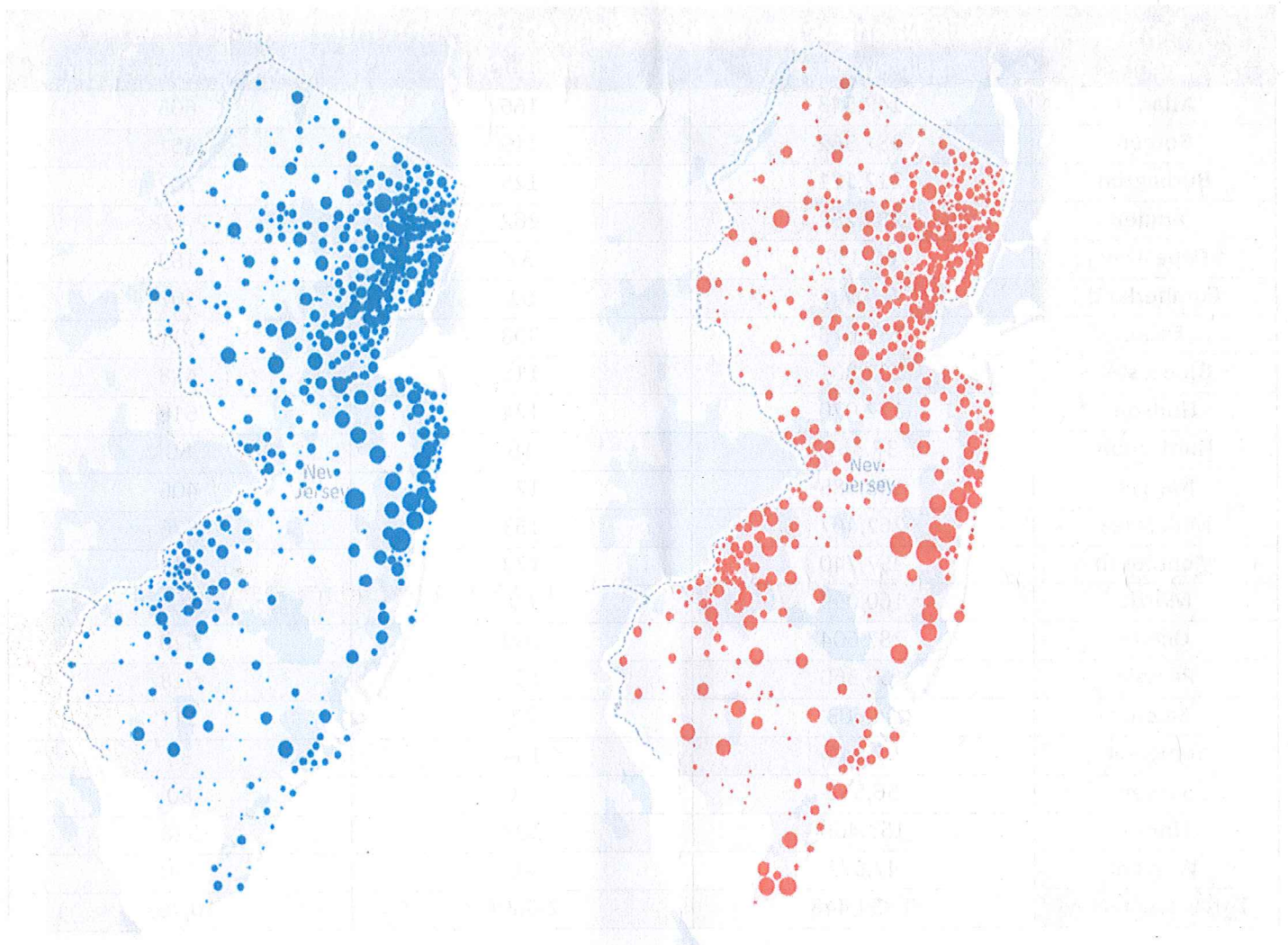




Figure 2: Heat maps of OUD Diagnosis for Commercial (excluding SHBP) and Medicare Advantage for 2017 by member count and county
